## **Grounds Report**

## Mt. Nebo Well #1

As I reported last month, we have pumped water out of the Mt. Nebo 1 well. However, we were experiencing some difficulties with the transducer instrument, and also some definite issues of gas being produced with the water, which affects how the pump operates and shuts off. Mark, and geologist Ben Jordan are investigating the instrument issues with the manufacturer, but the gas problem is a separate issue that will most likely require remedy. Options include a gas vent installed down hole, or possible air development of the well to clean up and reduce this problem. With the well being a temporary solution, there comes a point where the cost-benefit isn't worth it.
