Grounds Report

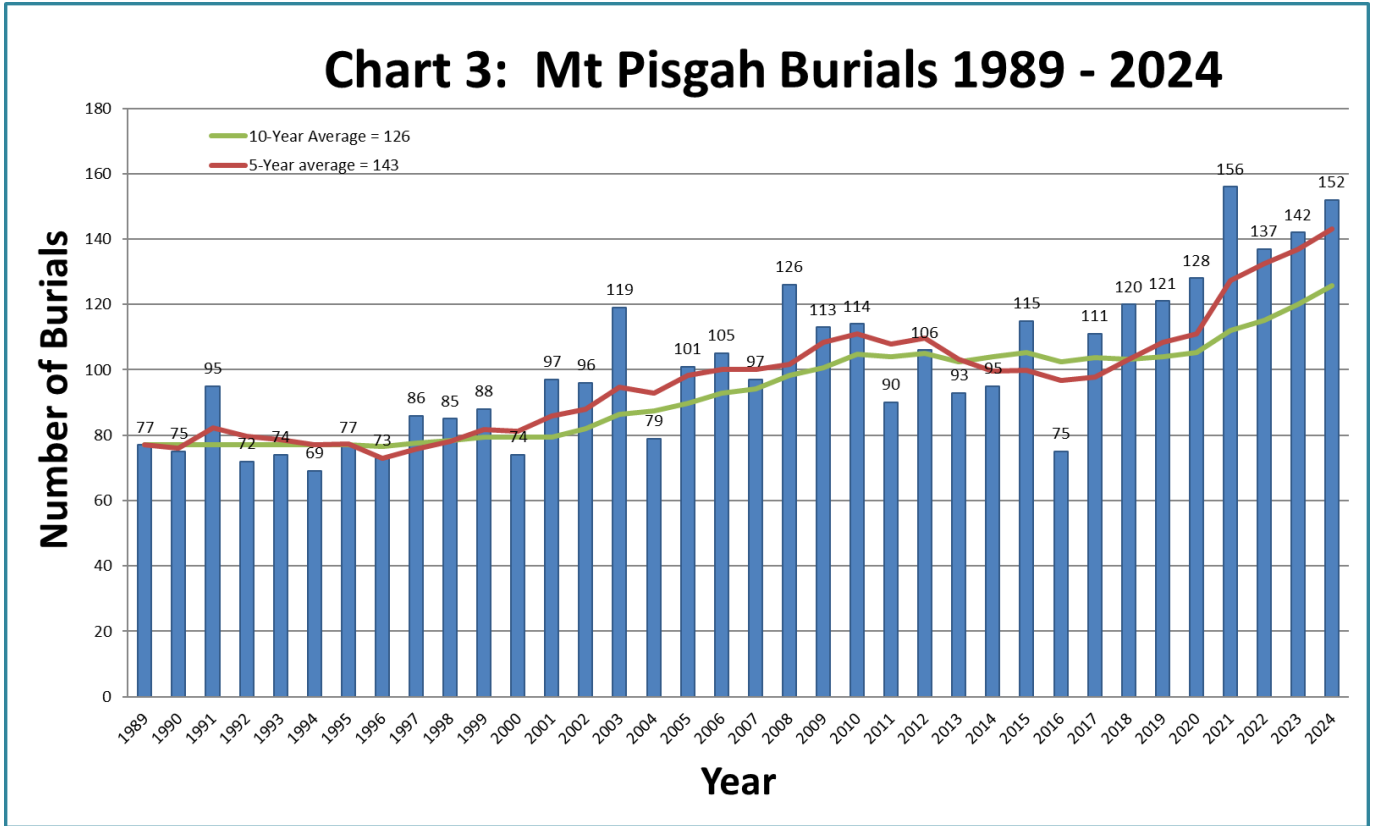

HB103

Draft legislation (see attached) has been submitted to the legislature for their consideration in the upcoming session. This updates and modernizes the construction of columbariums and mausoleums in the state of Wyoming. Scott Hunter from Laramie, and I drafted the suggested changes after consultation from some industry experts. The legislation is sponsored by two legislators from Laramie, Rep. Sherwood, Sen. Crum, our

attorney, Barry Crago and two legislators from Campbell County; John Bear and Abby Angelos. The primary sponsor, Rep. Sherwood from Albany County has asked that Scott Hunter and I make ourselves available once the bill gets assigned a committee to give comment and feedback to the process.
